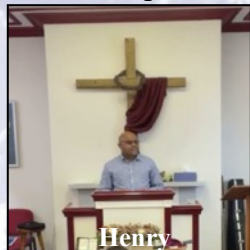

ed. The Christian Law Association has been very successful defending the right to preach the gospel publicly.

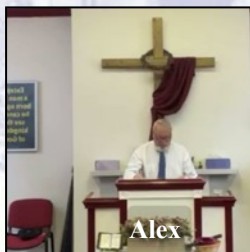
In **June** I scheduled three men of the church to preach a Sunday morning service. Henry, Garry and Alex preached some great messages.

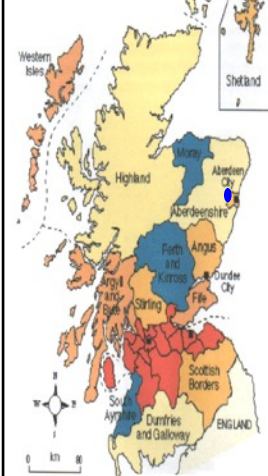
